Regarding the quick and correct conduction of engine tests we would like to suggest the following:

• One batch of engines should be smaller or equal to 20 pcs. and all team managers should have this in mind.


"Batch is defined as the engines required for one engine class in an event regardless of delay length. Maximum three batches are allowed per an engine class per an event".


• Because of the high temperatures expected we would like to ask all Managers to be prepared to provide the engines in an appropriate suitcase or a box the evening before the test. All of them shall be stored in a premise of low temperature. When a manager shows for a test to be conducted the latter shall receive the engines, being stored at temperature required by the Guide. We would like to all the teams to observe this requirement in order for us to be able to observe the test rules.

## 3.13.4 Static tests shall be conducted with the test engine at a temperature of 20 degrees Centigrade, +/- 5 degrees Centigrade.

After all the tests are conducted the engines shall be distributed in boxes for Seniors and Juniors, provided by the organization staff.
