The FAI and the Deutsche Aero Club e.V. would like to extend a warm welcome to all national teams taking part in the FAI Control line World Championship 2002 in Sebnitz.

## ***Competition categories***

F2A – Speed

F2C – Team racing

F2B – Aerobatics

F2D – Combat

The Junior and Senior competitions will be carried out together.

The individual categories will be held when at least four (4) national teams have entered.

The currently valid FAI Competition Code published in January 2002 will apply during the competition.

The official languages are English and German.

## ***Competition site***

The town of Sebnitz (350m above sea level) with 12000 residents is located in the Free State of Saxony and borders onto the Czech Republic. Sebnitz is situated 50km east of Dresden. Both venues are located on the outskirts of Sebnitz about 2000m from the centre of town: the World Championship Centre (F2A, F2B, F2C) and the World Championship venue at "Am Horn" (F2D).

## ***World Championship Centre***

This is where the Registration Centre for all teams is located along with the official office of the organisers and the competition office. Contestants will be competing for the title of World Champion in the Categories F2A, F2B and F2C. Flights in the categories F2A and F2C will be carried out on asphalt surfaces. F2B will be performed on a concrete surface. Two lawns are available for training for F2B. An additional concrete circular track is available for training for F2A and F2C.

## ***Venue "Am Horn"***

Circular competition and training circles for F2D will be prepared on a large field. 1000m from the World Championship Centre and close to this field the main parking lot for contestants and visitors is located.

## ***Access to the venues***

All contestants are requested to use public transport since only limited space is available at the venue car park. Busses are available within a radius of 12km for commuting between the two venues (World Championship Centre and venue "Am Horn") and the quarters.

A town map with a plan of the World Championship facilities will be provided to all participants who have registered.

All circular training tracks are available for free training sessions beginning July 10<sup>th</sup>.

You can fly direct to Dresden, Leipzig, Berlin or Frankfurt (Main) from many destinations in the world. Railway links exist between Sebnitz and all major airports.

Shuttle busses commute between the Sebnitz Railway Station and the hotels.

Busses and trains run every hour from Dresden Central Station to Sebnitz.

### Accommodation

**Category 1** Hotels \*\*\* with half board in Sebnitz and Neustadt, well-furnished and located not further than 12km from the World Championship Centre

**Category 2** Youth and tourist hotel (KIEZ) with 360 beds

in 2 and 4 bed rooms with beautiful outdoor area, restaurant, barbecue and playground, located 5000m from the World Championship Centre, shuttle bus available . Only a few single bed rooms are available

**Category 3** Camping grounds 5000m from the World Championship Centre featuring self-catering, shopping centre, swimming pool. Another small camping ground is located 500m from the World Championship Centre.

### Important information for reservations

To book accommodation in hotels and in the KIEZ in advance, you should inform us of your arrival day and the accommodation category you require no later than by 15.04.2002. This is important as Sebnitz is heavily frequented by tourists in the summer and some hotels are fully booked in advance.

The organisers reserved accommodation only for the time of the World Championship from 14.07.-22.07.

### Participation SENIORS

Each competitor must possess a valid FAI licence and the model aircrafts must comply with FAI regulations. Each country may register three senior contestants (F2C: teams) in each category, one team manager and one assistant team manager as well as one helper. The World Champions of 2000 are also invited to participate.

## **JUNIORS**

Each country may register one junior (F2C: junior team) in each category in addition to the regular team. The World Champions of 2000 are invited to participate in case they are still juniors.

Juniors will compete in the joint Senior and Junior competitions. The results will be announced separately. Should at least four (4) Juniors register in one category, Junior awards and a championship award will be presented. Should a Junior achieve a better result than the lowest result of any member of the Senior team, then his result will be counted towards the final team result. With the exception of the F2C competition where the pilot as well as the mechanic must be Juniors, Juniors are permitted to use Seniors as helpers (wherever helpers are permitted). Should two Juniors reach a top position, they will have a fly-off.

The results of these rounds don't count for the overall rating.

### ***Explanatory note:***

***Contestants are considered Juniors only up to and including the calendar year in which they turn 18. Junior contestants are therefore required to present documentary proof of their date of birth before registering.***

### ***Awards***

FAI diplomas for the 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place

All competitors will receive a certificate of participation.

FAI diplomas for the 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place of team members and team managers

### ***Catering***

Breakfast and dinner are available at the hotels.

A canteen at the venue will be serving hot meals for lunch. Breakfast can be arranged at the camping grounds.

### ***Entry fees***

The entry fee covers participation in the World Championships, access to flight grounds and gifts. All these payments shall be made in Euro. Fees in CHF are given for information only.

### **Fees must be paid before the 31<sup>st</sup> of May.**

Late registrations will be accepted at the discretion of the organisers.

Payments received between the 1<sup>st</sup> and the 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2002 will be subject to a surcharge of 10 % of the starting money, and payments received between the 15<sup>th</sup> and the 30<sup>th</sup> of June shall be subject to a 15% surcharge. Please note that registrations will not be accepted after the 30<sup>th</sup> of June.

### ***Medical insurance***

Each national team must purchase its own medical and travel insurance. The organiser's insurance is only a third-party insurance as required by the Sporting Code.

### ***Official bulletins and registration forms***

This bulletin No. 1 will be sent to all NACs who are members of the FAI.


