## $19^{\text{ TH}}$ WORLD RALLY FLYING FAI CHAMPIONSHIP $17^{\text{ th}}$ -22 $^{\text{nd}}$ of August 2014 TORUN, POLAND CONTEST REPORT

In the beautiful scenery of the City of Toruń, the Aeroclub Pomorski has hosted to the 19<sup>th</sup> World Rallye Flaying FAI Championship where 56 crews (pilot and navigator) from 16 countries plus FAI Teams were competed in two categories Advanced (34) and Unlimited (22). That is why the contest also had several new pilots who have entered to find out what rally flying is all about.

From 14 th up to 17 th of August all participant crews could fly their training routes.

Opening Ceremony started WRFC 2014 on Sunday the 17<sup>th</sup> of August with Air Show.



The first route RED started on Monday the 18th of August in both categories. Participants finished the route with competition landing but in the mean time wind conditions become out of the permitted limits and all landing results has been cancelled. Other crews landed without competition scorings.

The second route GREEN started on Tuesday the 19<sup>th</sup> of August in both categories. Participants finished the route with 2 competition landings. Some of them had crosswind conditions.

The third route BLUE started on Wednesday the 20<sup>th</sup> of August in both categories. Participants finished the route with 1 competition landing only. Some of them had crosswind conditions.



On Airfield of Aeroclub Pomorski during the WRFC 2014 were located Fun Zone where all interested could win flights, admire landings of participants coming back from routes, with large screen etc.



Official Closing Ceremony finished WRFC 2014 in Dwór Artusa in town centre, where all participants and guests coud admire fantastic gothic scenery of Torun.
