This report will combine the work of two prior committees; the Championship Management Committee and the Competition Development and Quality Committee. The IGC Bureau decided to combine the two committees into one.

The 2009 bid process is the first one in which the Plenum decision from a few years back to give preference to non-European sites begins. For the 2012 World Gliding Championships rotation the **15 Meter/ 18 meter/ Open** competition has this preference.
