

Proposal to change the rules for reduction of entries in case the number of entries exceeds the maximum number allowed

Proposal by Annex A Committee

It is Proposed:

To substitute the present text in Annex A Paragraph 3.4.3 c with the following text:

- c. Any number of entries is allowed if evidence is provided that the conditions and Local Procedures make it safe to do so (as per section 1.4.1) with a maximum of 50 entries per class.

If the number of entries per class exceeds the maximum of 50, or the total number of entries exceeds the maximum number of entries accepted by the organisers, the allocation of starting rights for the 2nd pilot per NAC (or 3rd pilot at Junior or Women Championships) will be made according to the Country Ranking of the IGC Ranking list, valid at the closure date for Final Entries for the relevant Championship

Exception: A NAC that has not entered 2 (3) pilots in each class will not lose a starting right until all Teams that have entered 2 (3) pilots have lost a starting right.

The new text will protect a low ranked NAC with a limited number of entries from immediately losing an entry in case of too many entries.
