50 persons returned the questionnaire, distributed as follows:


- 28 IGC delegates

- 5 Other meeting participants, such as committee chairman or experts





Subjects treated at the meeting












We try to do too much in to little time, either we should reduce the number of subjects, or reduce the number of items on the agenda




- 2,5 days would be better



















- A strategic issue should be discussed every year. This subject should be prepared, and experts should be ask to present e.g. their national initiatives or ideas.
























Comments: - To go to a different place every 3-4 years would be fine































- Native English speakers should speak slower

- The IGC-debate channel should be better managed and structured to address specific items, why not crate a forum for delegates.

































- Suggest to have a similar survey on the web to have the opinion of people not directly involved in IGC work.
