Note: entries from countries marked with (*) are accepted conditionally, there are still formalities to perform from their side. Respective Team Captains have been informed about details.

Online entries:

Entry list on our website differs a bit from the one above, since there are still a few pilots which haven't filled out online entry forms. Please check if all your entered pilots are visible in the "Entries" section of JWGC website. If a pilot is missing, please let him/her fill out the form as soon as possible. Links to online forms have been sent to Team Captains.

Entry changes:

Please check the entry lists and notify Organisers about any change or required correction on the entry list as soon as possible.

All changes within a class (change of pilot, change of glider) may be made till 27.06.2013. Informing Organisers by e-mail is sufficient for a glider change. For change of pilot, please prepare updated entry form.



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Rules for late entries:

Each class has limit of 50 pilots, so there is one free slot in Club class and 14 slots in Standard class. This slots will be made available to any country (within the limit of 3 gliders per class). Entries will be accepted on first-came first-served basis, with entry fee to be paid immediately after entry is made. If you're willing to make late entry please contact Organisers first at info@jwgc2013.eu.

Contest numbers visibility and similarity:

Rules regarding visibility of glider's contest numbers will be strictly followed during technical inspection. Refer to Sporting Code Section 3 Annex A, par. 4.3 for details. If you have any doubts if your glider's contest numbers are properly visible and readable, send a picture to <u>info@jwgc2013.eu</u> and you will be given a confirmation.

Issues of duplicate or similar contest numbers will be addressed to respective Team Captains directly.

Flight Recorder calibration

According to latest IGC plenary meeting decision, we will accept extended FR calibration validity of 5 years.

Unfortunately there is no possibility to do the calibration at Leszno.

Team Captain's checklist

We know that each Team Captain has many duties and things to care for before the Championships. To help you manage them, we have created a checklist for your preparations:

- Keep the original printed Entry Form and take it with you to Leszno.
- Check that all your pilots have valid FAI Sporting Licence. Take Licenses to Leszno.
- Check if any pilot requires TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption) for using medicines prohibited by anti-doping rules.
- Obtain a written parent's approval for any person under 18 travelling without them. It should indicate adult team member responsible for the minor.
- Check if your intended Flight Recorders are still certified recently some old FRs have lost IGC approvals! Please also mind that since February 2013 all FLARM units have to be upgraded to 5.08 software to be valid as Flight Recorders.
- Check if all Flight Recorders have intact security seal. You may send a sample IGC file from each FR in question to our special e-mail: <u>igc.upload@gmail.com</u>. We will check file security and inform you about the results.
- Check if all Flight Recorders to be used have valid calibration chart (valid 5 years, see above).
- Check if you have necessary cables and software to download your Flight Recorders.
- Remove all instruments forbidden by Local Procedures from gliders.
- Check and take with you all required glider documents, including valid weight&balance certificate. The latter should be made with same instrumentation as will be used during the Championships.
- Check if glider is due for maintenance during the Championships. If so, prepare for it.
- Check for glider's equipment, including wing and canopy covers, wing/tail dollies, batteries, chargers, water tools and anchors.
- Check gliders' third party insurance for validity during World Championships. Hull damage insurance is not mandatory, however it's recommended to check it too.



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- Check personal (medical) insurances of all members of your team.
- Check if each pilot is equipped with GSM or satellite phone. For most cases, pilot's personal phone is sufficient, provided it will operate in Polish network (i.e. roaming is enabled).
- Take with you an extra GSM phone without "SIM-lock". You will use it with Polish SIM card. Don't forget the charger.
- Carefully re-read Bulletins and Local Procedures with your pilots.
- Let pilots download and fill out Registration Forms in advance. Take Forms to Leszno.
- Bring your national flags and anthem as specified in Local Procedures.
- Read "Practical Tips" at our website to get some knowledge of what to expect in Poland.
- Last but not least, don't forget to prepare something for the International Evening :)
