

Serbia National Report

1. Traditionally NAC of Serbia organize the *Kite Competition of Serbia* which was held in Belgrade in May 2011 and took about 200 participants from Serbian elementary schools. The main organization was held by Non Government Organization "The Children Friends". During the competition the other discipline like paragliding, free flight model aircrafts, rocket-modeling, gliding were presented and demonstrated.
2. Free flight model aircrafts competition was especially promoted in F1N and F1150 class (junior hand made models). In a competition which was held in Nova Pazova in June 2011 about 120 junior participants were involved.
3. In November 2011 the Young Artist Exhibition supported by NAC and FAI was held in Aeronautical Museum with 562 participants from 34 schools and the best works were awarded. During the exhibition 100 children from Subotica were awarded by museum visiting tour.
4. On December 3rd 2011 The International Coup for Indoor Models was held in Belgrade Fair Hall I. Owing to ideal competition conditions, the organization of the next competition in 2012 was proposed Europe in the same environment by other National Organizations of Europe.
5. Total of 7 Junior Camps all around Serbia were organized and among them 5 paragliding competition training camps were held.
6. To stimulate junior competition the Managing Ccommittee decided to grant the Competition License for free to first-time competition participants.
7. The Young Talents Foundation was established by NAC also in 2011.
8. Public Media Seminar for junior aeronautical sport competitors was organized by NAC in 2011. The seminar addressed themes such as public media communication fear which adversely affect aeronautical sport presentation and popularization.
9. The best junior "The Golden Eagle" was awarded to Milica Marinkovic for the World Paragliding Championship second place in Paragliding Precision Landing Open Championship which was held in Czech Republic.
10. The Ministry of Sport and NAC granted 10 scholarships to the best young competitors.
11. NAC publish The Aeronautical Magazine regularly.
12. G-zone was announced in the flight control air space by Civil Aeronautical Directory and NAC participate in the air space classification seminar.
13. NAC of Serbia organized the 105th General Conference FAI in Belgrade in October 2011.
