FAI Licences - New Rules

At the 2012 CIAM Plenary meeting, the text, in bold below, was unanimously approved to be added to the rule.

The implementation date is **01 Jan 13**.

ABR rule B.3.2 Sporting Licences.

Names on FAI licences must be completed using the Roman alphabet. If it is deemed necessary by a NAC that the names have to be written in an alphabet common to its country, then the licence must also *show* the name in the Roman alphabet.

Competitor names as entries in competition lists and results must be listed using only the Roman alphabet.

Note: It is expected that family name will be written in capitals eg PERGONY, Ivor
