In addition to providing for SC S5, the purpose of the ISC Library includes maintaining a thorough archive of past competitions, as well as maintaining a complete resource for ISC judge training courses.

### 2020 STATUS

 On September 17, 2020, it was announced on the FAI web site (at the below URL) that FAI/ISC judges may receive free access to the ISC Library. This was to allow FAI/ISC judges to refresh their judging skills during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Judges requested and received ISC Library content.

- 2) For 2020, one (1) TB of MicroSoft OneDrive (cloud storage) subscription for one year was purchased for the ISC Library. However, MicroSoft didn't accept a number of e-mail addresses to deliver the ISC Library link and, during ISC Library access activity, there was an account lock-out that interrupted service. Thus...
- 3) The ISC Library has begun the process of moving to a WeTransfer subscription service. FAI/ISC Judges reported that it is easier receiving ISC Library content via WeTransfer.
- 4) One competition was added since 2019 Annex 25b:

This collection includes Canopy Piloting Distance, Speed, Zone Accuracy, and Freestyle.

In order to prepare the CP videos for transfer over the internet, it was necessary to remove from the videos the long periods of time when there were no canopies flying in the course, to reduce the file size of the collection from 136 GB down to 33 GB. This required 26 work hours.

Thank you to Claire King (InTime) and Andrew Toit for providing the videos and documentation for Canopy Piloting.

There are no other new competitions added to the ISC Library as FCEs in 2020 have been cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

## **DISCUSSION POINTS FOR 2020**

1) The GPS log files for Wingsuit performance and Speed Skydiving are "pertinent documentation." These GPS log files are equivalent to the video files for the video events (AE, FS, CF, etc.) "Recording media" includes the GPS log files, and these files should continue to be included in the ISC Library.

2) Canopy Piloting and Freestyle Canopy Piloting were provided to the ISC Library.

3) Both MKV and MP4 have been acceptable video file formats.

Based on the above points, the following is recommended phrasing for 4.9.3 (1): "The Scoring System operator at an FCE (other than for standard CP) must give a copy of the recording media (including data log files, such as .CSV) of the competition (in an MKV or MP4 format for video), together with the summary score sheets and other pertinent documentation, to the FAI Controller. The FAI Controller will deliver the copy of the recording media and the documentation to the Chair of the ISC Judges' Committee and/or the ISC Judge Video Librarian, who must ensure that each Delegation can purchase copies of the same within 45 days of the end of the FCE."

4) For Canopy Piloting, there needs to be a more time efficient procedure to remove video footage during the periods of time when there are no canopies flying the course. Any recommendations to the ISC Librarian for accomplishing this would be greatly appreciated.

5) There are some discussion points still outstanding from previous years' ISC Judge Video Librarian Reports, including inclusion of music in the videos (and resolution to copyright issues) for those routines performed to music, and archive of Competition and Performance records. The ISC Library still does not have any media or documentation of Competition and Performance records.

### CONCLUSION

Competition videos, data and pertinent documents are essential for developing judge skills and improving scoring systems as well as for competitors and future competitors to develop their skills. These materials are "reliably" available through the ISC Judge Video Library. And we want to preserve history.
