Proposal for changes to the ISC Competition Rules for Freefall Style and Accuracy Landing

Date: 14 August 2021

Place: Kemerovo DZ, Mondial 2020

Story of the changes:

During last few ISC Meetings Freefall Style and Accuracy Landing Committee proposed different changes to the competition rules related to the participation of juniors. Initial reason was to give chance to juniors to compete in Senior teams and still be ranked in junior category, but current version of the rules has irrational (not in favor of athletes) and uncomfortable issues:

1. Team coach / athletes must choose before the start of the competition the category (Senior or Junior) for the individual classification of athletes. This means that a coach should decide what is better – to lose one of the overall individual results in Senior team or to lose the individual result in Junior category to save chances for Senior team. In our opinion this rule deprives the equality of the athletes' rights.
2. Current rules bring too many difficulties in calculating of the results for Judges and are not clear for athletes in final scoring table.
3. It is a violation of the rules of fair play if a Junior cannot win in Senior classification if his or her results are better. Besides in other air sports Senior and Junior WC/EC are separate competitions with different dates and place, so junior athletes have an opportunity to take part in both events.

What we suggest:

To give full possibilities for all Juniors to compete in both Junior and Senior categories at the same competition. Therefore, every team can have a male and a female team, which can include Juniors, who will be ranked in both categories in all disciplines, plus 2 male and 2 female Juniors who will be ranked also in both categories. So it won't change the number of athletes and the composition of the delegation but teams can decide how many Juniors do they want to put in Senior team without any restrictions. *We should discuss limit for number of Juniors. OR NO LIMIT WITH COMMITTEE / PLENARY*
