72nd ISC Plenary Meeting CANOPY FORMATION COMMITTEE REPORT Bucharest, Romania

One CF FCE was held in 2021, the 19th World Championships of Canopy Formation at the Mondial in Tanay, Russia. The Committee would like to thank the Russian Skydiving Federation, Denis Svidirov, and all of the organizing staff and the numerous volunteers for hosting this premier event. The CF competition was comprised of both the 2-way sequential event (8 teams) and the 4-way rotation event (5 teams). Unfortunately, due to lack of teams, the 4-way sequential event had to be cancelled. A number of suggestions came out of the competitors meeting and the CF Committee will be discussing each of these suggestions in our closed meetings.

The CF Committee has brought up and discussed the cancellation of the 4-way sequential event in the past few years at these plenary meetings. While the Committee discussed allowing this event to go forward at the World Championships in Eloy, the Bureau will bring a vote to the plenary floor to permanently retire this event from world competition. Since this is a vote for the plenary, some background is in order. Please see the table below for participation levels:
