I would like to thank the members of Judges Committee for their work during 2021. They have been committed, available and reliable during our meetings.

I would also like to thank the ISC Bureau Members who have worked so hard to enable the Mondial to take place.

The Judges Committee has had 11 working meetings during the year where we dealt with judge issues. Many hours were spent creating documents for system requirements and for process description for approval of the judging system.

During the year 2021, many judges would have lost their ratings, so the JC planned and performed a re-evaluation for all who needed it.

The JC will begin to look for a solution for an on-line re-evaluation system.

Mondial 2020 (2021) – Tanay, Russia

Due to the Covid situation, there was great difficulty in filling judging panels. Some countries did not allow their judges to travel abroad at all, or to travel under strict quarantine requirements after returning to their home country. It caused many to drop out from their judge assignments. All of the CJ's made great effort to assemble panels. We used judges with double ratings to judge different events, and these judges stayed extra days at the competition.
