Temporary Working Group for Disabled Parachuting was created in 2016, with the aim of achieving many objectives. During these years with the great enthusiasm and assistance from French Parachute Federation there were conducted 4 HandyFly Challenges in different countries. And working group really hopes that this motion will find further support and interest from more countries.

Competition rules, written by enthusiasts from FPP are improving from competition to competition.

In 2020 French Parachute Federation came up with the new initiative. France has got a Grant from European program "ERASMUS" and started to organize a #WH EVENT, consisting of competitions in the wind tunnel of iFly Aix-Marseille and a competition of HANDIFLY RACE.
