Details of the Judges Work: (including judging statistics)	There were 67 competitors i CP Standard and 42 i CP Free Style. During OPD 1 and 2 was 443 jumps judged (123-zone, 127-dist., 127 sp. and 66-free st.). During the competition was 733 (201 in each standard event and 129 -free st.) judged in. In total was 1176 judged (981 in standard event and 195 -free st.). Ther were 5 rejump (3 of them were problem with parachuts and 2 was becouse of course issue). An injury occurred. During OPD, the judges practiced both judging and various positions on the course. The second OPP an official course closing drill was conducted as a full practice. The FAI Controller approved the system that was practiced.
