Changes to competition rules 2024 proposed for approval

No changes to indoor rules.

See AE outdoors draft.

Changes to Section 5:

6.6.1.2 Panel of Judges:

(2) "...The other FAI Skydiving Judges required will be selected by the CJ from the annual nomination list (6.5) of available FAI Skydiving Judges. **The CJ must select 1 Judge not previously selected for an FCE in that discipline**, for a panel of up to 10 Judges, and 2 Judges not previously selected for an FCE in that discipline if the panel is greater than 10"

The AE committee asks to exclude indoor freestyle. With a only 3 judges on the panel (including the EJ), judging live, an unexperienced judge might be under too much pressure, resulting in unfair scores.

Since the Mondial in 2021, 11 NEW AE judges entered the cycle, 3 of them on a fast track to EJ/CJ. In some panels, 4 new judges were included. Some others were invited and refused. It is better to let a new judge into the formal competition, where there is a 2nd view, and better mentoring by the EJ.

Competitions – 2022

Indoor –

April 2023 - World Championship – HF Tatralandia, Slovakia.

There were very challenging conditions, with air temperature up to 45 degrees during training.

The air during competition was held under 37 degrees. But that was very different from the air the competitors experienced during training.

Our rules, including Section 5 and the bidding process, must keep in mind the max temperature allowed, and how the bidder can prove it is within the limit prior to the competition.

- Indoor Freestyle Open - 20 competitors from 16 NACs
- Indoor Freestyle Junior – 10 competitors from 7 NACS.

August 2023 – World Cup and European Championship – Voss, Norway
