He flew his first competition in 1987 And has competed in 35 national championships and has been representing the Netherlands in every Cat1 event he was eligible for.

The technological developments haven't always been easy for Henk but he has found a way to work with it and still score well.

So well that this year Henk managed to become National Champion again for the 20th time. We believe the accomplishment of winning a national title for 20 times deserves the recognition of a Montgolfier diploma.
