

2022 CIVL Plenary COVID Testing Requirements and Protocols

To promote the safety of all the attendees of the CIVL Plenary, and to be consistent with other international sporting organizations, the following protocols will be in place for the 2022 CIVL Plenary:

- All in-person attendees will be required to present a negative PCR or Antigen test for COVID-19. This is true regardless of vaccination status and/or recovery from COVID-19. The test results must be dated no earlier than Jan 24th. For attendees that have a COVID-19 test that was required for air travel, the same test may be used provided that the results are not older than Jan 24th.
 - Test may be available on-site, but this is not guaranteed, so any attendees not already required to provide a negative test result to travel should test prior to arrival or bring a self-administered test with them to be done on-site. Self-administered tests must be the type that are verified by a tele-health organization.
 - All test results should be emailed to Elena at: civil_comps@fai.org prior to the start of the Plenary.
- All attendees are required to wear masks during the meeting and any group functions, except while eating or drinking.
- Any attendee showing symptoms of COVID-19 are encouraged to voluntarily test again and may be required by the CIVL President to take a new test.
- Anyone without a negative test prior to the Plenary will not be allowed to participate in person.
- Anyone testing positive during the Plenary will be required to complete their participation virtually from their hotel room or elsewhere.
- Costs associated with testing are the responsibility of the attendee's national organization.
