My modelling career began in the early 60s. I was a regular British team member until 1984 with three British National wins in 1969, 1970 and 1977 plus I was European Champion in 1979 in F2D.

In the early 80s I was instrumental in introducing a Vintage combat event to the BMFA and F2E to CIAM. I was GBR's FAI delegate for 2 years in the early 90s.
